

Cross Country Community:

Brighton High School (BHS) is looking forward to Cross Country events this season. As I am sure you have also experienced in these unprecedented times, we will have some new procedures and guidelines in place at our home sporting events. Listed below is an outline of our new procedures and guidelines, all of which have been put in place based on State and Local Health Department Guidelines.

Athletic Directors and Coaches: Please share this letter with your runners, coaches, and fans as it outlines the policies and procedures that will be in place throughout the 27J School District.

- Brighton High School will not be charging admission for entrance into Cross Country events. While we will not be charging admission, there will be restrictions related to the number of people in attendance at our events.
- Entries deadlines will be determined by the Host school. No JV or open races will be allowed at Varsity meets. There can be a total of 50 runners per gender. Up to 3 coaches per team will be permitted at events.
- Guests - Guests will be determined by the site host and local health department regulations.
- All runners and coaches are strongly encouraged to bring hand sanitizer and apply frequently.
- Masks -
 - All runners must wear a mask while on our campus or at an event. Exception: runners do not have to wear a mask when ACTIVELY running the course, but they are required to keep the mask with them throughout the duration of the race.
 - All coaches must wear a mask while in the athletic complex or at an event. This includes while coaching. Players and coaches must also practice social distancing whenever possible.
 - All fans and game day personnel must wear a mask at all times while inside of our athletic complex/event and must practice social distancing at all times with anyone that is not a member of their family. Anyone unwilling to comply, will be asked to leave.

We are taking as many precautionary steps as possible to ensure the safety of everyone in attendance and doing our part to ensure the resumption of sports in Colorado. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we navigate these uncharted waters and we look forward to a great cross country season.
